Main sources of information

- Administrative statistics (including annual census)
- Household survey
- MICS survey
- DHS survey
- Population census
- Case study, performed by NGOs

MDA Indicators

- 6 EFA goals with corresponding indicators (18 main, 50 additional)
 - → revision of information by indicators is required
 - → defining of set of indicators
 - → frequency of indicators

Problems identified in the course of discussion

- Absence of data on some indicators:
 - In dynamics
 - By gender/age/ethnic background
 - By living standard
- Vagueness of some indicators methodology:
 - Adult literacy criteria
 - Reach by professional-technical and technical education
 - Preschool education (no records on non-formal preschool education)

Problems identified in the course of discussion

- ► Time limits for data input
- Selection data from a great number of sources

Database Creation

- Excel template to calculate indicators
 - → develop a sample to calculate coefficient of primary education level
 - → use existed sample to calculate coefficient of primary education level for calculation of next secondary education level reach coefficient
 - → adaptation by classification level
 - → adaptation and use of EFA MDA samples (Bangkok version) for creation country database to insert in DevInfo
