Main sources of information

- Administrative statistics (including annual census)
- Household survey
- MICS survey
- DHS survey
- Population census
- Case study, performed by NGOs



MDA Indicators

- 6 EFA goals with corresponding indicators (18 main, 50 additional)
 - revision of information by indicators is required
 - defining of set of indicators
 - frequency of indicators

Problems identified in the course of discussion

- Absence of data on some indicators:
 - ▶ In dynamics
 - ▶ By gender/age/ethnic background
 - ▶ By living standard
- Vagueness of some indicators methodology:
 - ▶ Adult literacy criteria
 - ▶ Reach by professional-technical and technical education
 - ▶ Preschool education (no records on non-formal preschool education)



Problems identified in the course of discussion

- ▶ Time limits for data input
- ▶ Selection data from a great number of sources

Database Creation

- Excel template to calculate indicators
 - develop a sample to calculate coefficient of primary education level
 - use existed sample to calculate coefficient of primary education level for calculation of next secondary education level reach coefficient
 - adaptation by classification level
 - adaptation and use of EFA MDA samples (Bangkok version) for creation country database to insert in DevInfo
